2011 Annual Landfill Report Update

One requirement of the Lambton landfill operations permit, granted to Clean Harbors by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment, is the provision of an annual report that details landfill activities and the onsite environmental monitoring programs conducted during the year.

This annual report is approximately 1,000 pages and presents a detailed compilation of the environmental monitoring programs conducted at the site in addition to a summary on the volumes of wastes received and details of any cell excavation work done during the reporting period. The reporting year runs from September 1 to August 31.

We have started to make good progress in dealing with the volume of leachate water onsite.
