



**NOTICE OF SUBMISSION  
PROPOSED TERMS OF REFERENCE  
CLEAN HARBORS LAMBTON LANDFILL EXPANSION**

As part of the Clean Harbors Lambton Landfill Expansion Environmental Assessment (EA), Clean Harbors Canada, Inc. is submitting a Terms of Reference (ToR) to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment (MOE) for formal review and approval as required under the provincial *Environmental Assessment Act* (EA Act). The proposed ToR have been prepared pursuant to subsection 6 (2)(c) and 6.1(3) of the EA Act, which enable proponents to focus the EA and consideration of alternatives to address their specific needs and circumstances. If approved, the ToR will provide the framework for the preparation and review of the EA for the proposed undertaking.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to provide landfill disposal capacity for hazardous waste. The selected alternative is intended to provide adequate disposal capacity for hazardous waste designated for landfill disposal over the 25 year planning period. Clean Harbors has identified the need for approximately 4.5 million to 5.0 million cubic metres of landfill capacity to manage waste at the Lambton landfill over the 25 year study period.

The public review period for the ToR will be from **October 9, 2009** to **November 8, 2009**. You may review the ToR during normal hours of operation at the following locations:
