Clean Harbors Announces Plan to Pursue Expansion of Landfill

Sarnia, Ontario – April 21, 2009 – Clean Harbors Canada, Inc. announced today that the company plans to apply for an approval to expand its Lambton landfill in St. Clair Township. Existing operations at the facility will reach capacity in approximately four years. The Lambton landfill is Ontario's only hazardous waste landfill, and provides an essential service to Ontario industries and public agencies including the disposal of household hazardous waste for many municipalities.

The company intends to complete a terms of reference for an environmental assessment (EA) of a proposal to develop additional capacity at the landfill pursuant to the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The terms of reference will describe those studies to be carried out during the EA and is expected to be submitted to the Ministry of the Environment for review and approval in the fall 2009. These studies are expected to consider potential environmental effects from the alternatives related to groundwater, air quality, noise, dust, odour, agriculture, surface water, natural environment, archaeology/cultural resources, and design and operations. If the terms of reference are approved, the EA studies are expected to be completed during 2010.

The landfill has been in operation since 1960. This EA will enable Clean Harbors to continue providing secure disposal service at current operating levels for a 25 year planning period.

The public and stakeholder consultation phase of this process will begin immediately. The company has planned an initial Public Open House to introduce the project to the public and stakeholders on Wednesday, April 29th at the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 447, 350 Albert Street in Corunna, Ontario from 4:00 PM to 9:00 PM.
