Clean Harbors' Container Program provides collection, storage, transportation and disposal services for our upstream customers. Bins are typically placed at gas plants, oil battery facilities, and pipeline terminals to assist our customers in effectively managing their hazardous debris including filters, rags, pads, and other solid Dangerous Oilfield Waste (DOW).

Clean Harbors' turnkey program provides customers with flexibility and a variety of solutions to manage their waste. Bins are placed in various areas of a customer's facility, usually at key points of production where waste materials are generated. The containers are used to support environmental programs and the recycling and disposal needs of our clients.

Steel or poly bins with liner bags provide our customer with secure secondary containment of the hazardous debris generated on site.

Variety of Containers and Sizes

Container sizes range from 1 to 2.5 m³ in steel or double walled poly design, to 6.1 m³ lugger containers, and 20 to 40 m³ roll off containers. Volumetric options allow our customers to choose the right size container for their specific needs. Whether it is an ongoing collection program or a major spill response in remote areas, our fleet of containers can solve your on site collection, transportation, and disposal requirements.
